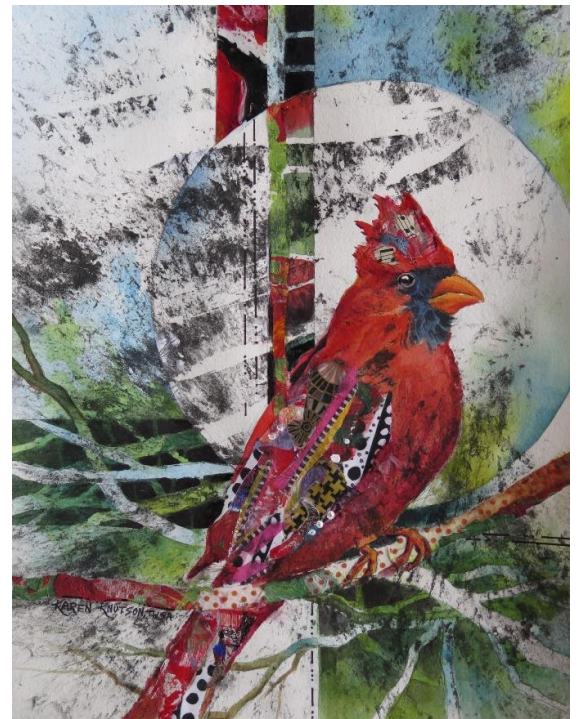


Watercolor and Charcoal Pours, (painting birds and birch trees)
