

## LIST OF SUPPLIES FOR WATERCOLOR – 2019

**GOOD PAPER:** 140lb. Fabriano sheets (bright white or traditional watercolor paper). Use Arches if you already have it. **Bring the paper you have.** I also like Saunders Waterford Rough 140 lb paper for Landscapes

**PALETTE:** Mijello Folding Palette (22 or 33 wells). Available on Amazon

**PAINTS:** Windsor Newton Paints (not Cottman), Holbein or any other professional grade paint equivalent to Windsor Newton Professional or Holbein paints.

**PAINT COLORS:** \*Indicates important to have

**BRUSHES:** It's important to have a good brush that holds water and applies paint easily, has a nice point and will hold its shape. I prefer to Use Natural Sables, but he also sells Synthetic in the same brand. \*Cheap Joe's Legend Kolinsky Sables size#8 (this brush is round) costs about \$25.Others can be pricey. They have a set of round brushes sizes 2,4,6,8,10,12 for about \$150....or just buy a round 8 and 10 size. **Treat yourself to good brushes!** Cheap Joe's: 800 227-2788, [www.cheapjoes.com](http://www.cheapjoes.com)

**EASELS:** Table easel or regular easel...or something to prop up your paper surface. **Foamcore...just buy a 20x30 sheet cut in half or use what you have.** They have inexpensive table easels but come to class first to see what others are using, I also use Gatorboard

**Sketchbooks:** Good options are Aquabee Super Deluxe Heavy Weight drawing pad (60 sheets 9"x12") or American Journey Watercolor Journal ((9" x 12") from Cheap Joe's.

**Misc:** Kneaded Eraser, Regular Eraser, #2B Drawing Pencils  
2 Containers for Water, Spray Bottle and small mist bottle, Paper Towels  
Scrap Paper, Tracing Paper (is good to have)  
Art Tape (WHITE)  
Scotch Tape, Bulldog Clips
