Drawing Materials

- 18x24" spiral-bound drawing pad, Strathmore 400 series (brown or green cover)
- 2B graphite drawing pencil
- white plastic eraser by Mars Steadtler or Maeped
- kneaded eraser
- small pencil sharpener
- - small pack of soft natural charcoal sticks, willow or grapevine (not compressed charcoal, nor charcoal pencil)
- unscented hairspray for preserving charcoal drawings (for the 4th class)

N.B. An inexpensive set of drawing materials by NICOLE, available at AC Moore, contains: graphite pencils, white plastic eraser, kneaded eraser, pencil sharpeners, compressed charcoal pencils & sticks. This set is OK for the 2B pencil/white & kneaded eraser & sharpeners.

You still need to get the soft natural charcoal separately.

For later on if you like:

- **pen & ink** (not needed in the first classes):
 - **MICRON, waterproof, archival black ink, sizes 03 (sm.) & 08 (lg.)**
other sizes are available – try other brands, colors, non-waterproof for fun!
